**Great News for Arizona's Tuition Tax Credit Law**

The United States Supreme Court announced this morning that they will consider ending the lawsuit challenging Arizona's tuition tax credit program.

Specifically, the Supreme Court will review the 2009 decision by the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals that held this program to be unconstitutional. It is expected that the Supreme Court will hear arguments in the fall.

Today's action is very good news for the thousands of children attending all private schools, including Catholic schools, that otherwise would not be able to attend without this support.

The Arizona Catholic Conference is grateful for the very good work being done by our friends at the Alliance Defense Fund and the Institute for Justice who are litigating this matter and will provide further updates as events unfold.
