The Course

This approach to the Catechesis of children is based on the work begun with Dr. Maria Montessori and further developed by Dr. Sophia Cavalletti in Rome.

This course provides training for catechists working with children 3 to 6 years of age. Phoenix Diocesan equivalency can be granted toward Catechist Certification as well as Continuing Education credit for Catechetical Leaders.

This course will :

- ◆present the methodology and guiding principles of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd for the 3-6 year old child.
- ◆explore the religious nature and the most vital religious needs of the 3-6 year old child.
- ◆meditate on the Biblical and Liturgical themes presented to the 3-6 year old child.
- ◆broaden your ability to observe and learn from the child, to listen to the Scriptures with the child, to deepen your own enjoyment of God.
- ◆offer guidelines and assistance in preparing the 3-6 Atrium environment, and in making the catechists album and Catechetical materials.
